
Do's & Don's Don'ts

of connecting on LinkedIn

How to connect on LinkedIn properly and increase your acceptance rate

Do's

- Explain WHY you want to invite THIS person
- Personalize your invite before approaching someone
- Find something in common
- Explain what value you can offer to them
- Adapt your message and tone to the position and context
- Keep it short (you have 300 characters including spaces)



- Don't write multiple paragraphs about yourself. Get to the point.
- Make your invitation generic

"We have common interests"
What interests?

"We share connections" Why does that matter?

- Pitch your product/service in your connection request
- Don't ask for favors, you haven't earned that right
- Misspell someone's name
